Team Results

There were two undefeated teams going into the championship game...the Sea Dogs and the Sky Chiefs. The Sea Dogs won a dramatic 9-inning game vs. the Aeros on 10-year veteran camper Luis Liceaga's RBI game-winning hit to right field. Both teams had to bring in their aces after the 5th inning. In the end, Paul Carswell outlasted Fred Clough in a duel for the ages. Dennis Murphy led the Sea Dogs in the first game vs. the Drillers.

The Sky Chiefs beat the Red Barons 12-2 in Saturday's opener. Paul Muller, Jr. led the hitting attack going 2-2 with 2 runs and 2 RBI's. In their second game, Ed Costantini added two more RBI's to give him 11 RBI's in 3 games.

Pitching:

Hitting:
